Additional comments from the Evaluation Panel were as follows:

Valuable project developing potential of existing interview transcripts to study diversity issues in engineering, with sharp observations on gender issues associated with PBL. Gender is the major concern but are other forms of diversity included in the design? Some lack of clarity about the relationship between skills/skills deficit and diversity. Is there value in conducting new interviews?



Very solid proposal that makes use of existing potentially valuable data. Would have liked to see more detail on how this was generated, why it may be suitable for phenomenological analysis, and assurance that all ethics and GDPR protocols followed. All sections of application very strong, detailed and relevant.
